Mosquito Control Fog Truck Driver

Are you independent, self-motivated, and enjoy working outdoors? Four Rivers Vector Control District (FRVCD) is seeking self-motivated individuals for seasonal Vector Control Fog Truck Driver (April – September). The Fog Truck Driver duties are to protect and serve the public from the annoyance of mosquitos and the harmful diseases they carry. The position will require employee to operate a district owned vehicle equipped with an ultra-low volume insecticide spray to control mosquitos throughout the district. Hours are evening, night and/or early morning, depending on the district needs.

Mosquito Control Field Technician:

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must have and maintain a valid driver's license during employment.
- Must provide a DMV driving record print out prior to employment.
- Must pass the ODA Public Pesticide Applicator exam within 30 days of hire (employer paid exam, training provided.)
- Must be able to traverse uneven and rugged ground.
- Must be able to work outside for extended periods of time in extreme heat.
- Must be able to routinely lift and carry up to 50 pounds.

Minimum Education Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent, or combination of education and experience that

provides the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform a satisfactory job performance.

Experience:

- No experience required but general familiarity with mosquito biology and their life cycle, or knowledge regarding control of other insect pest species is desired.

Essential Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Operate vehicle equipped with ultra-low volume insecticide sprayer.
- Under the direction of District Manager surveys for and monitors a variety of mosquito sources and habitats such as ditches, marshes, water troughs, etc. within the FRVCD district.
- Performs work outdoors in sometimes steep, rugged terrain; works in all weather conditions including intense heat during summer months.
- Correctly identifies life stages of mosquito and treats areas as needed with appropriate mosquito control products accordingly.
- Operates and maintains a variety of specialized equipment.
- Respond to citizen service requests.
- Maintains accurate records of mosquito control product applications and inventories.
- Operates a district owned vehicle and keeps assigned vehicles clean and in good working condition.
- Trapping and collecting adult mosquitoes for West Nile Virus testing.
- Acts in a professional and courteous manner at all times, particularly when interacting with the public.
